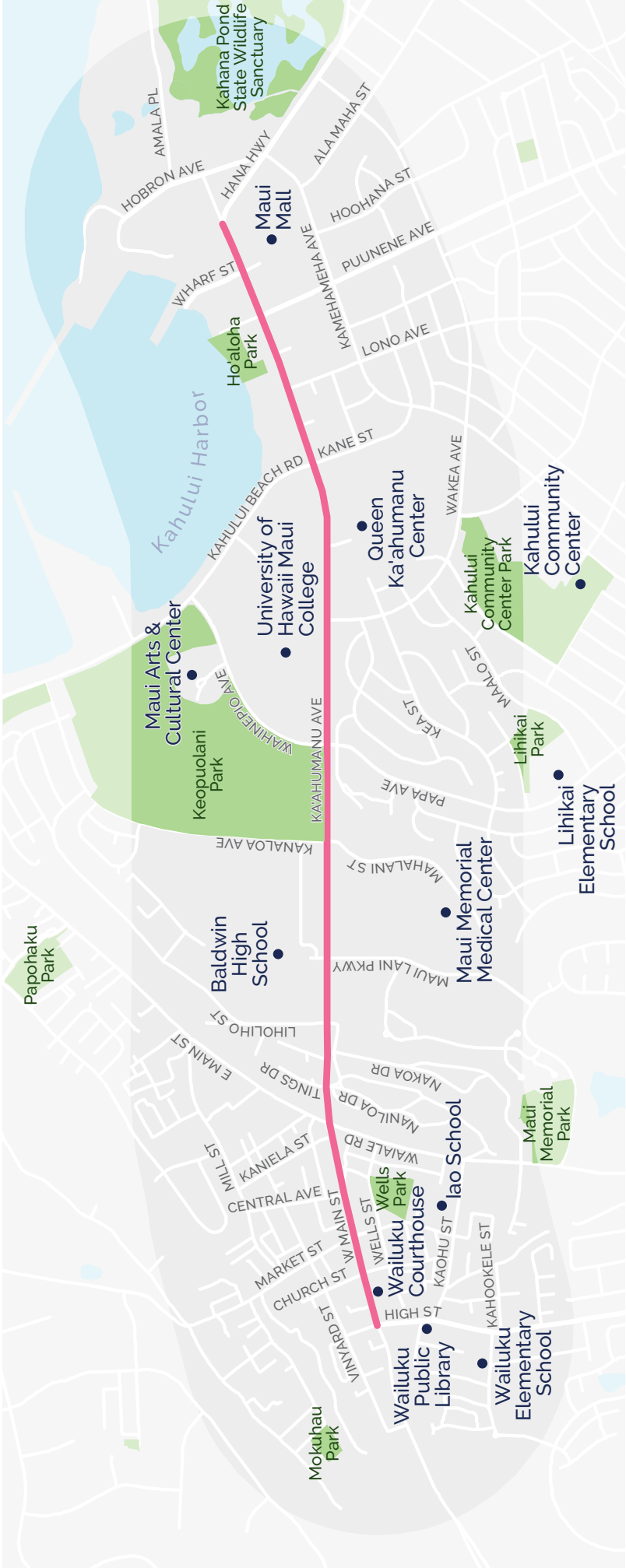


Tell us about your experiences traveling in our project area by putting your ideas on the map. Where do you go? How do you get there? Where is it hard to walk or cross the street?
